From Greenville: Take Poinsett Hwy (25/276) North and turn right on N. Pleasantburg Dr. (291). Take a quick left onto State Park Rd. Go 2.5 miles and bear left at the fork (at sign to park).

From I-385: Take N. Pleasantburg Dr. (291) and follow the signs towards Furman University. Just past Rutherford Road, take a right on Piney Mt. Rd. Take a right on State Park Rd. Go 2 miles and bear left at the next fork (at sign for park).

From Traveler's Rest and points north: Take State Park Road south to Mt. Creek Road (at Mt. Creek Baptist Church). Take right. Follow to stop sign at top of hill, take left, Park is on right.

May 23- Carnivorous Plants. Presented by Kyle Rollins. Discover how some plants capture and digest insects as one of their nutrients.

June 27- Impacts of Urban Sprawl.

Furman University Hydrogeologist, Dr. Weston Dripps will discuss the impacts of urban development on local stream systems in the Greenville area.

July 25- Bees And Beekeeping.

Muff Harner will explore the world from the point of view of the bees that pollinate our plants and thus play a major role in the natural world.

August 22- Rocks and Minerals.

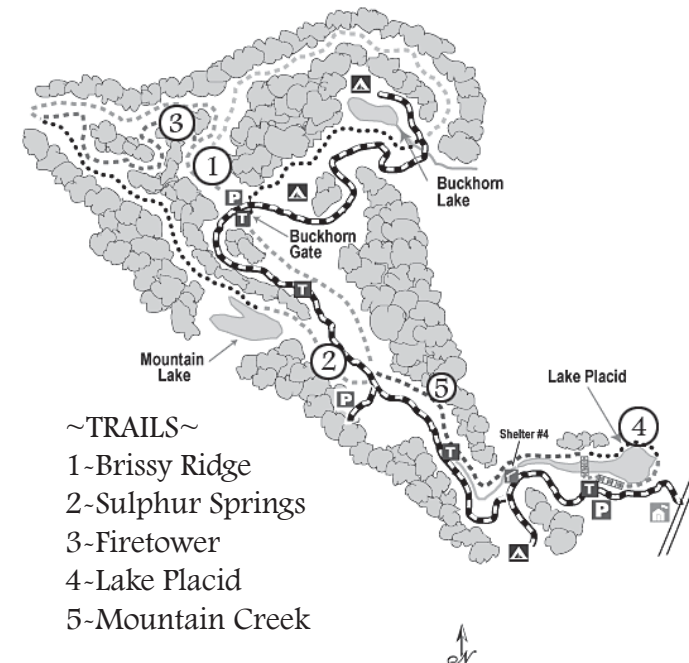
will provide the main course. Meeting place to be announced.
